MHCP posted Provider Update MHS-11-01 on December 20-2011 regarding coding changes for CTSS.

South Country Health Alliance has adopted the following coding changes. Providers will need to use the H2012 and the appropriate modifiers for CTSS Day Treatment provided on or after January 1, 2012.

Prior Authorization is required after the threshold is met. Provider must complete the Minnesota Universal Outpatient Mental Health Authorization form and fax it to: MMSI Health Services (888) 889-7822

CTSS Authorizatn threshold is 150 hours per calendar year.
