CD Rate Reform Changes

- Prior Authorizations required for **all** services
- Forms on SCHA website: www.mnscha.org
 - Located on Provider tab, click on forms, then scroll down form list to find specific form
 - Also located at:

- New Forms
 - CD Request Worksheet (SCHA #1762)
 - CD Admissions Form For All Levels of Care (SCHA #1761)
 - SCHA CD Complexities Grid (SCHA #1763)
- Updated Form
 - Chemical Health Coding Structure effective July 1, 2011

Form usage

County/CD Assessors

- Complete Full Rule 25 Assessment (DHS #5204)
- CD Request Worksheet (SCHA #1762)
 - These forms will be required to request approval for services

CD Treatment Provider/Facility (Inpatient, Outpatient, Methadone)

- CD Admission Form For All Levels of Care (SCHA #1761)
 - For all new admissions
- SCHA CD Complexities Grid (SCHA #1763)
 - For all new admissions
 - Once in treatment, if complexity level changes
- Rule 25 Assessment & Placement Summary (DHS #2794)
 - To request continued stay

Payment considerations

To receive payment for completing the Rule 25 Assessment:

- County/CD Assessors must fax these documents to MMSI (888-889-7822):
 - CD Request Worksheet (SCHA #1762)
 - Full Rule 25 Assessment (DHS # 5204)
- If forms are not received, claims for the assessment (HCPCS code H0001) will be denied

To receive payment for R&B and/or treatment:

- Provider/facility must bill their expected CCDTF rates approved by DHS
- SCHA will compare claim against SCHA CD Complexities Grid and the CCDTF Rates file, if claim does not match, claim will be denied

Claims for CD Treatment Services

- Must be submitted to SCHA/MMSI using the appropriate AUC coding structure
- Reimbursement will be driven off the SCHA CD Complexities Grid Form
- Claim must match SCHA CD Complexities Grid, otherwise claim will be denied.
- Provider expected to send in new updated SCHA CD Complexity Grid Form or adjust the claim, whichever is incorrect.

Changes - CD Coding Structure Grid

- Outpatient Services, Treatment only
 - HCPCS codes
 - H2035 – Individual
 - H0005 – Group
 - Providers should not use code H2036 for billing purposes. Refer to the AUC Companion Guide.

Billing Services that overlap June and July

Billing Requirements:

Claims that overlap the months of June and July 2011 will need to be split.

- Bill the month of June one claim
- Bill the month of July on a second claim
- Claims for the month of June will be paid according to the CCDTF rates in effect on June 30th 2011.
- Claim for the month of July and forward will be paid according to the CCDTF rates in effect as the time services were provided.
