

Help prevent FRAUD, WASTE, AND ABUSE

South Country believes it is the responsibility of everyone to report suspected fraud, waste, or abuse.

What is Fraud, Waste, and Abuse?

- Fraud: An intentional act of deception, misrepresentation or concealment in order to gain something of value.
- Waste: is the overutilization of services, or other practices that, directly or indirectly, result in unnecessary costs to the health care program.
- Abuse: is excessive or improper use of services or actions that are inconsistent with acceptable business or medical practice.

How to prevent Fraud, Waste, and Abuse

Members can help South Country uncover provider fraud, waste, and abuse by keeping track of the following things:

- Who provided your health care
- What services you received during the visit and any additional tests or visits the doctor orders
- When you got a health care service
- Where the service took place
- Do not sign blank medical services documents

Call South Country if you think the provider may have billed wrong or offered a service you didn't think you needed. Please remember, do not:

- Give your ID card or numbers to anyone other than your doctor, clinic, hospital or other health care provider
- Ask your doctor or any other health care provider for medical services or supplies that you don't need
- Sign your name to a blank form
- Share your medical records with anyone other than your doctor, clinic, hospital or other health care professional
