*\*\*The condition to pay under the direct access list is that the Nurse Practitioner (NP) (SP19, SP04, SP81, SPAV, SP1P) or Physicians/Physician Assistant (PA) (SP79, SPPA) must have rendered the service in a specialty clinic and the NP/PA must be affiliated with a physician specialty listed below. They are to be paid without an auth only if the place of service is a specialty clinic. This direct access without an auth does not apply to NP and PA when the service are rendered at a primary care or multi-specialty clinic.*

THIS IS FOR MN, ND, SD, IA & WI PROVIDERS ONLY. ALL OTHER STATES WOULD REQUIRE AUTHORIZATION.

*\*\*The condition to pay under the direct access list is that the Nurse Practitioner (NP) (SP19, SP04, SP81, SPAV, SP1P) or Physicians/Physician Assistant (PA) (SP79, SPPA) must have rendered the service in a specialty clinic or the NP/PA must be affiliated with a physician specialty listed below. (i.e.: Neurologic Clinic of Mpls; Medical Advances Pain Specialists, Minnesota Gastroenterology, etc). They are to be paid without an auth only if the place of service is a specialty clinic. This direct access without an auth does not apply to NP and PA when the service are rendered at a primary care clinic or multi specialty clinic. An exception to this would be if the PA is acting as an assistant surgeon, and the surgeon's specialty is on the Direct Access list.*

THIS IS FOR MN, ND, SD, IA & WI PROVIDERS ONLY. ALL OTHER STATES WOULD REQUIRE AUTHORIZATION.

Pediatric age limit is defined as up to age 21 (member's age on the DOS). This is the age DHS uses to distinguish between child and adult members.

*\*\*The condition to pay under the direct access list is that the Nurse Practitioner (NP) (SP19, SP04, SP81, SPAV) or Physicians/Physician Assistant (PA) (SP79, SPPA) must have rendered the service in a specialty clinic or the NP/PA must be affiliated with a physician specialty listed below. (i.e.: Neurologic Clinic of Mpls; Medical Advances Pain Specialists, Minnesota Gastroenterology, etc). They are to be paid without an auth only if the place of service is a specialty clinic. This direct access without an auth does not apply to NP and PA when the service are rendered at a primary care clinic or multi specialty clinic.*

*EXCEPTION: PA or NP at Children's Hospitals or if the PA is acting as an assistant surgeon, and the surgeon's specialty is on the Direct Access list will be allowed.*
